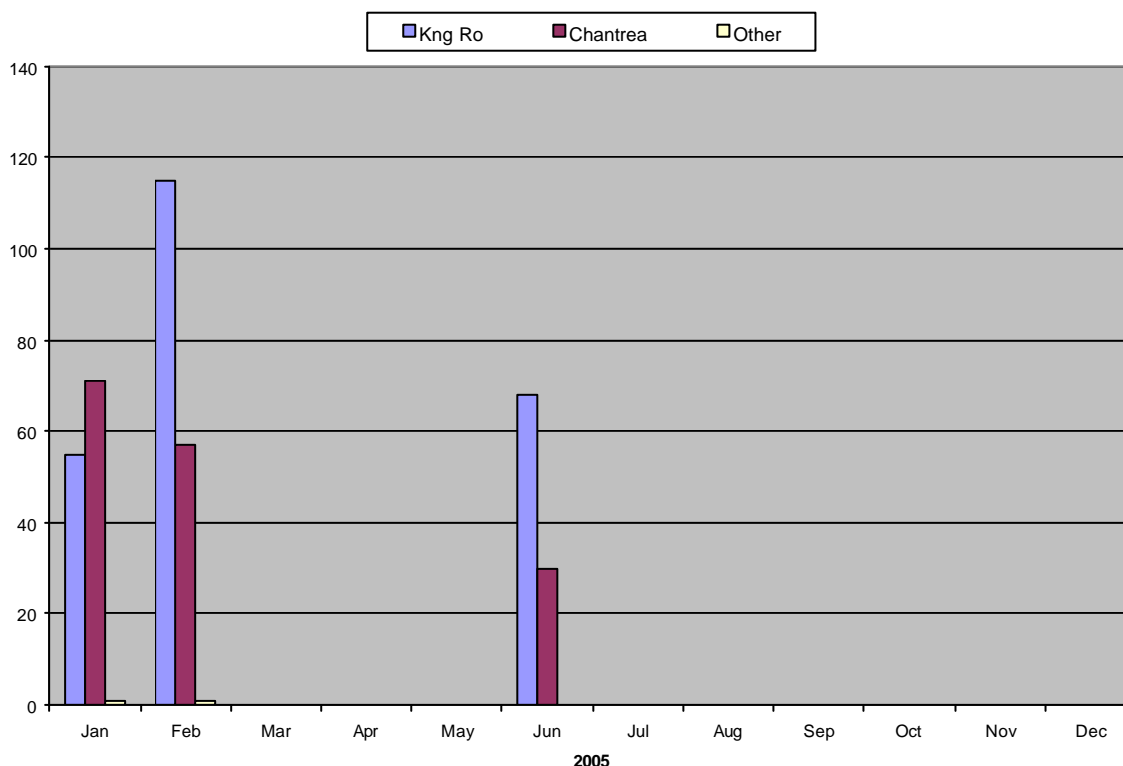
**Return and Reintegration of Cambodians from Viet Nam to Cambodia

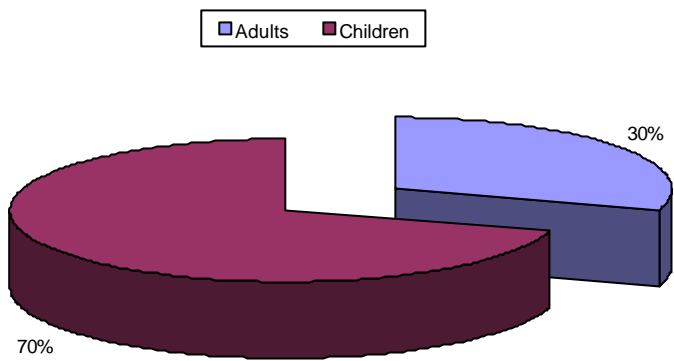
- 3 instances of repatriation,
- Totally 396 were returned. Most (59%) were from Kompong Ro
- 2 (1%) were from places other than Kompong Ro or Chantrea, namely one from Svay Chrum District of Svay Rieng and the other from Kompong Chnang. All were adults and when to VN as irregular migrants
- Most (70%) were children, of whom 58% were girls
- Of all the adults, 79% were female
- Of all the returnees, 72 (19%) were identified as victims of trafficking, of whom 4 were assisted twice this year. All reported to have been trafficked for begging.

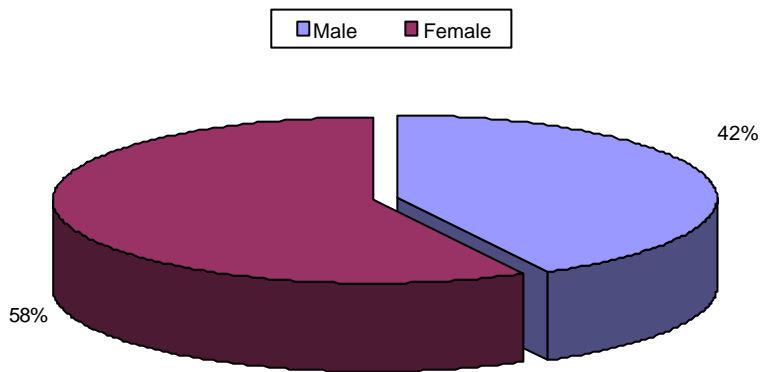
Cambodian Returnees by Month by District
